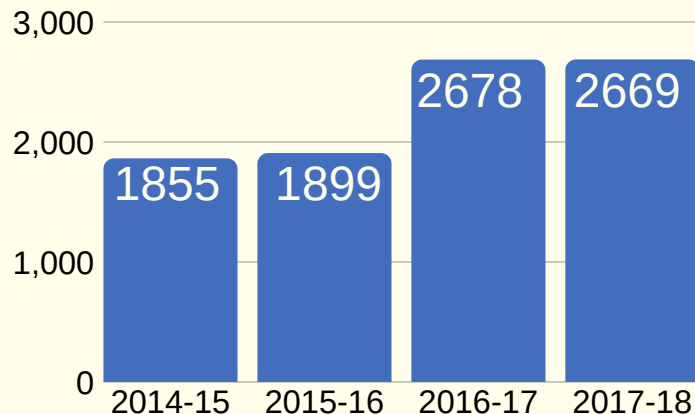


# GBEMIS SUMMARY 2019

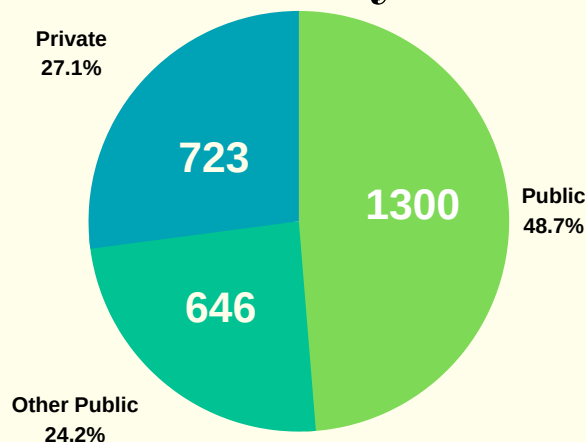

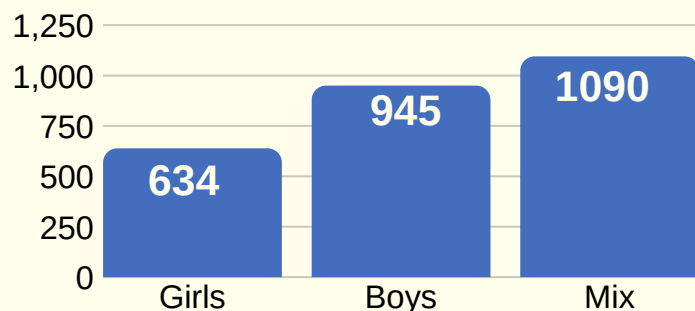
## Number of Institutions at GB

There are 2697 Schools across Gilgit-Baltistan, out of these 1328 are Government Schools. Among 1328 Government School in Gilgit-Baltistan 1300 are functional and 28 are non-functional. Out of the 1328, there are 877 Boys and 451 Girls schools, which are further classified as 798 primary, 280 Middle, 230 High and 20 Higher Secondary Schools

There are 2697 Schools across Gilgit-Baltistan, out of these 1328 are Government Schools. Among 1328 Government School in Gilgit-Baltistan 1300 are functional and 28 are non-functional. Out of the 1328, there are 877 Boys and 451 Girls schools, which are further classified as 798 primary, 280 Middle, 230 High and 20 Higher Secondary Schools

Besides 1328 Government Schools there are 646 Schools managed by Federal Government (BECS and NCHD Feeder Schools), Army, GB Police and Pakistan Bait-ul Mall and 723 schools are managed by private sector.
